HOW TO FUND YOUR GRIZZLYCORPS FELLOW

Launched in 2020, GrizzlyCorps is an AmeriCorps Program in partnership with UC Berkeley's Project Climate at the Center for Law, Energy, & the Environment (CLEE).

GrizzlyCorps understands that the \$20,000 match can make it difficult for some organizations to partner with us. We hope to support our partners as much as possible to ensure that this is not a limiting factor.



WE HOPE THAT THE FOLLOWING ADVICE WILL HELP YOU PLAN AND PREPARE FOR HOSTING A GRIZZLYCORPS FELLOW:

Plan in Advance | Consider writing the cost of your fellow into your grant applications and/or coordinating with other regional organizations/projects/departments to apply for grants together.

Consider In-kind Contributions | GrizzlyCorps is willing to consider housing and other contributions as in-kind donations toward your match. Explore community resources and housing opportunities for your fellow. In some cases, other regional partners may have housing available that could accommodate an additional fellow (such as communal housing at local research stations or cooperative extensions).

Payment Plans & Sliding Scale | GrizzlyCorps has offered sliding scale options and payment plans for partners that are a promising match for our program. Contact us to learn more about whether you are eligible.

Explore Community Foundations | Community foundations are regionally-based foundations that address community needs by supporting the financial needs of local organizations and projects. They can support regional work through donations, grant-making, scholarships, and fundraising support.

Start a GoFundMe | GrizzlyCorps is happy to help with all types of fundraising activities, including utilizing our media outlets to share GoFundMe links or other fundraising materials. Although this type of fundraising may seem insignificant, even \$5000 will cover 25% of your \$20,000 match.
